- LE LUDE

«This magnificent château, lying on one bank of the Loire, offers visitors a fascinating mixture of styles: medieval and Gothic, with its big, round towers; Italian Renaissance, with its layout, its dormer windows and medallions; and Louis XVI, with its harmonious riverside façade. You are sure to be as impressed by the quality of the interior tapestries, woodwork, exceptional paintings, and exquisite furniture, as by the superb park overlooking the Loire.»

- MALICORNE

"The stones of the Château de Malicorne reach right down to the water's edge. From the bridge, there is a charming view of a mill and the poplar-lined river banks. An 11th century church holds the recumbent figure of a lord of Chaource, a Pietà (in the right transept) and, on the left wall of the nave, a lovely 16th century piscine, a small basin for holding sacramental water. The Château de Malicorne, with its turrets and Mansard roofs, once belonged to the Marquise of Lavardin.»

- SOLESMES

"From the bridge and the right bank of the Sarthe, there is an impressive view of the abbey, with its somber 50 meter wall, built in Romano-Gothic style at the end of the 19th century. The buildings are reflected in the waters of the river; an 18th century priory, less imposing but more graceful, extends their length. Only the abbey church (at the back of the main courtyard) is accessible to the public. This church consists of an ancient (11th-15th century) nave and transept, with a dome-vaulted choir added in 1865.»

- LE MANS

«Le Mans, capital of the province of Maine, satisfies all appetites. For gourmets, there are local pork specialties, fragrant reinette apples, and organic chickens; art lovers appreciate the grand cathedral with its apse, portals, and stained glass windows; walkers ramble through the city's alleys and its quays along the Sarthe; and, for lovers of speed, there is the famous race track with its mythic Hunaudières (or 'Mulsanne') straight.»

- TOURS

«Tours, the largest city in the Loire Valley, with Orléans and Angers close behind, is the capital of the traditional province of Touraine and formerly a 'royal city.' Tours has no fewer than three historic districts, perfectly preserved: the Old City, with its Plumereau Square and medieval and Renaissance houses; the Saint-Julien District in its center; and, further east, the Cathedral District, the seat of the Catholic archdiocese. Enjoy fascinating long walks, strolling along Tours' shopping and pedestrian streets, and chance upon small secluded squares, beautiful hotels, and gardens. And, when it's time for something more restful, visit the peaceful Saint-Cosme priory, with its roses and the memory of its long-ago prior, the poet Ronsard.»

- SAUMUR

- USSÉ

The Château d'Ussé, overlooking the Indre River and at the very edge of Chinon Forest, was the inspiration for Charles Perrault's fairy tale, 'Sleeping Beauty.' Established on the foundations of an 11th century fortress, it was built during the 15th and 16th centuries. The interior houses Flemish tapestries and Asian weapons. The Guard Room has a beautiful ceiling. The King's bed chamber and the chapel in the park are worth a visit.»

Booking conditions for hotel rooms

1. By 'group' is meant a minimum of 5 rooms, or 15 people traveling together with the same arrival and departure times.
2. On request we can offer an identical price for all rooms, regardless of their comfort category.
3. We offer 1 free room with a booking for at least 20 rooms (except during event periods). On request, we can carry luggage in and out at no charge.
4. Bookings may be made by mail, fax, or email.
5. A 30% deposit is to be paid upon confirmation of the reservation. (We do not reserve rooms without this payment, except for SEH corporate customers.)
6. Rooming list one month before group arrival
7. Balance to be paid at check-in using a bank card, or in advance of arrival by bank transfer (except for event periods).
During event periods: a second payment of 40% deposit 90 days before the event and final payment 1 month before the event
8. Cancellation conditions (except for event periods)
 - Cancellation before 90 days: refund of deposit paid
 - Cancellation from 90 to 45 days: 50% of the departure reservation
 - Cancellation from 45 days to 30 days: 70% of the departure reservation
 - Cancellation of from 30 days to no-show: 100% of the departure reservation

GETTING AROUND

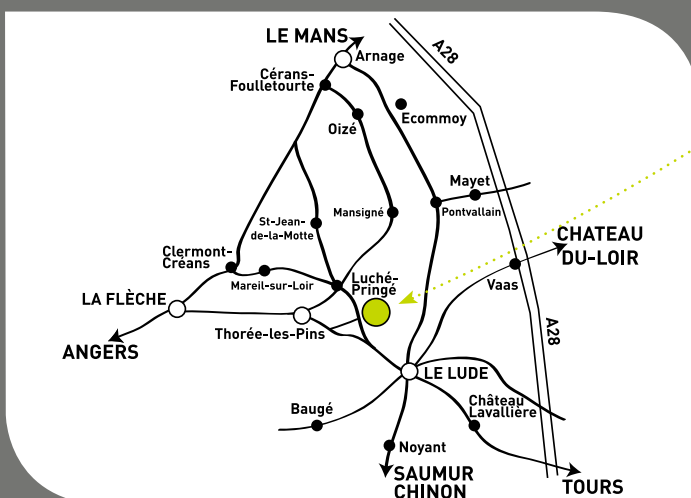
Le Domaine de la Courbe is located on the D54 :
Route du Luché-Pringé in Lude.

We are on the doorstep of Maine, Anjou and La Touraine, close to the towns of le Mans, Tours, Angers and 2 hours from Paris on the A28 motorway.

By A28 take exit 26 towards Lude. Cross La Lude towards Laval then continue for 3km on the D 306 and head towards Luché-Pringé on the D 54.

coordinates lat. 47.67173; long.: 0.11252 – Don't confuse us with la Grande Courbe.
